■ Period of the program

- Unavailable periods: 20 March – 6 May, December 28- 3 January, Summer holidays (2nd or 3rd week of August- the exact dates are announced around June or July of the year.)
- Also, short-term international students cannot start and/or finish their programs on June 18 (University holiday) and Japanese national holidays.

■ Required Documents

1. Applicant Information Sheet
 2. Curriculum vitae
 3. Official request letter from Dean or the official representative of home institution to the Dean of Department / Graduate School of Medicine.
 4. Copy of passport (Photo and biographical page)
 5. Certificate of Health (Designated form or free form in English*)
* If you submit in a free format, please also attach our designated form filled only section 7 with the physician's signature.
 6. Immunization Record for International Students (Only for clinical elective)
 7. Color ID photo (headshot, H3.3 cm x W3.0 cm for Student ID card use)
- Submit all of the required documentation data file to kyoumu-in@mail2.adm.kyoto-u.ac.jp
 - The title of each data file must include the aforementioned number and your name e.g. "2. CV_YOUR NAME.pdf"
 - Submission Deadline: **three months prior to the proposed start month**
**For countries that are not exempt from visa requirements, we would suggest submitting documents 4 months prior to the elective start month.

■ Visa

In principle, a Short-Term Stay Visa (短期滞在) is required for short-term international students.

Some countries and regions get the requirement for the visa waved.

■ Housing

Each student is responsible for finding his/her own housing. Please note that the availability of housing is variable and cannot be guaranteed.

■ Insurance (International Travel, Health and Liability)

Short-term international students are required to have international travel and health insurance throughout the period of study in order to covering the costs of any medical treatment or damage compensation they may require.

All international students are also required to purchase Personal Liability Insurance for Students (*Gakubai*) which is provided by the University Co-op on the first day.
